§ 2 Registration of participation in the Event

- 1. Anyone who participates in the Event in any form is a formal participant of the Event.

- 3. Participation in activities requiring prior registration without making it is not possible except for the situation of resignation from participation by a registered Participant.

Rules for participation in the Event on-line
